Reception	21 st June 2018	Creepy Crawlies in York	£18	To experience different animals with friends and develop knowledge of how animals live. To grow confidence and independence.
1 & 2	4 th October 2017	Yorkshire Wildlife Park	£15	To develop an understanding of animal needs in general but to look closely at the differences between the needs of polar bears and meerkats; this supports learning in the topic "Why Can't Meerkats Live in the North Pole?"
1 & 2	7 th March 2018	Skipton Castle	£13	To support the topic of "Castles" this trip will enable children to develop a much deeper understanding of why castles were built, how they were used and what life was like for people who lived in and around them.
3,4,5 & 6	20 th November 2017	Royal Armouries	£12	Using historical objects and primary sources children will explore the lives of local men, women and children during the Great War. Children will also reflect on the significance of remembrance and create their own remembrance pots to take home.
