Attendance

Once again, I would like to thank you all for working so hard with us on improving our attendance.

Currently attendance for the whole school is 95.27% and the percentage of pupils who have missed 10% of their learning so far this year is at 12.74%.

This is a much better position than last year when, at this stage, attendance was 91.82% and persistent absenteeism was at 33.91%.

Punctuality

While our attendance is improving it would appear that our punctuality is getting worse. We regularly have children late to school – some children are late more often than they are on time and we are often sat waiting with children for parents to collect them after school.

We will now begin to call parents in for meetings to discuss punctuality in the same way that we have done for attendance as even 5 minutes late at the start/end of the day can have a hugely negative impact upon children in school.

Academic results and much more

As I am sure you will all have seen, we did amazingly well last year with our year 6 SATs results. We came 8th in Kirklees and 3rd in our local area of Kirklees for children gaining the expected level in Reading, Writing and Maths.

As a small school, these results can vary enormously when each child can account for between 4 and 5 percentage points but it is always worth celebrating success.

We also value and celebrate the efforts your child(ren) put in to all aspects of school life – we appreciate children who are kind, who use good manners, who are good at non-academic aspects of the curriculum and we love those children who try hard even when they find it difficult.
